In the morning, we will enjoy a guided, one hour tour of this extravagant, former seaside palace built for King George IV. The building is famous for its unique architecture and has been compared to the Taj Mahal due to the onion domes and minarets. The lavish Chinese inspired interiors demonstrate King George's love of luxury and opulence.

After the tour, members will be free to explore The Pavilion and its gardens as they wish. Refreshments and light lunches will be available in the Royal Pavilion café, or in any of the many nearby restaurants. The seafront is a five minute walk away.

In the afternoon, a short walk through the Royal Pavilion gardens will bring members to the Brighton Museum and Art gallery. Here you will find an eclectic mix of Fashion, Textiles and Fine Art along with local social stories and exhibits. Entrance is included in the cost of the visit and members are welcome to enter the Museum at any time they wish after 1.00pm
